6 – 11. Project Location

- Geocode and address should reflect where the majority of beds are located
- Zip code and Geocode must match
- DV providers should only enter Geocode and Zip Code

14 - 23. Bed Inventory

- Inventory is broken down by household type
 - Inventory Start Date
 - Inventory End Date
 - Beds/Units
- Cribs and overflow beds are not reported in this section
- All projects except RRH: Beds/units should remain the same as the previous year unless units/vouchers were added or removed



Bed Inventory: Families

- Projects with a fixed number of units but not a fixed number of beds should multiple their average family size by the number of units to determine bed count
- Review the <u>Average Family Size</u> kb for more details



Bed Inventory: Voucher Projects

Voucher projects should determine bed counts from the number of bedrooms in each unit

Households without Children

0 bedrooms – 1 bed 1 bedroom – 1 bed

Households with Adults & Children

2 bedroom – 3 beds

3 bedroom – 5 beds



Bed Inventory: Tenant-Based PH/RRH Projects

- Beds and units should reflect clients active in the project and placed in a PH unit on the night of the count
 - Beds = number of clients in each household type
 - Units = number of families in households with children and adults
- HMIS Projects: Run the Count of Persons by Household Type report for these numbers



Bed Inventory: SSVF EHA

- Clients that meet the following criteria on the night of the count must be counted as a separate ES project NOT participating in HMIS:
 - Active in SSVF RRH project
 - NOT placed in permanent housing
 - Receiving Emergency Housing Assistance service
- SSVF RRH HMIS Projects: Run the 2022 SSVF EHA Clients report for these numbers



33 – 42. Dedicated Beds

- Dedicated beds must be filled by clients from that subpopulation.
 - Chronically Homeless (PSH only)
 - Veterans
 - Youth




45 - 48. RRH Max Capacity

- Report the maximum number of clients and households the project can serve at one time
- These numbers should match what is included on the project's contract
- HMIS projects without contracts
 - Run the RRH Number of Enrollments and Households in a Given Week report
 - Find the week with the most active enrollments
 - Run Count of Persons by Household Type report for a date during that week



RRH - Number of Enrollments and Households in a Given Week





51 - 54. Active Clients

- Number of active clients in each household type
- ES/TH projects: These numbers must match the project's PIT data
- RRH/PSH/OPH: Count active clients in the project and placed in a housing unit




51 - 54. HMIS HIC Reports

All reports are available on the Data Analysis tab under HIC/PIT




Count of Persons by Household Type Report

- All members in a household should be assigned the same unique Household ID as alphabetic group names






2022 Sheltered PIT: Client Data
